Day 1 May 14, Thursday: Depart USA

This evening depart New York's JFK International Airport via Lufthansa for our overseas journey to Frankfurt, Germany. Complimentary meals and beverages will be served on board. (D,B)

Day 2 May 15, Friday: Arrive in Frankfurt | Mainz | Rudesheim

Arrive at Frankfurt International Airport. Proceed through Passport Control, claim our luggage, and meet a Peter's Way tour manager upon our exit from Customs. Board our comfortable motor coach and drive to the city of Mainz, situated on the Rhine River. Mainz has been a trading center since Roman times. It is the capital of the state of Rhineland-Palatinate, a university city, and the center of the Rhine wine trades. Independent lunch. After lunch, we'll continue to Rudesheim am Rhine for hotel check-in. **Celebrate Mass at a local church before dinner.** Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rudesheim. (D)

Day 3 May 16, Saturday: Rudesheim | Rhine River Cruise

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will walk a short distance to the river and board our boat for a cruise through the most picturesque part of the Rhine Valley. We will pass castles, vineyards, barges, trains, and historic villages. Many castles are in ruin, but some have been restored as hotels and are open for tours. They stand as sentinels on the cliffs above the villages, while others are surrounded by vineyards that stretch as far as one can see. The narrow 35-mile gorge connecting Bingen and Koblenz, a UNESCO World Heritage site, has more castles than in any other river valley in the world. After our cruise, we will meet the coach for a ride back to Rudesheim. Independent lunch.

After lunch, enjoy a free afternoon on your own. We suggest a tour of the Asbach Uralt distillery (*at additional cost*). Asbach Uralt is a German brandy first distilled in 1892 when Hugo Asbach (1868-1935) founded the company in Rudesheim am Rhein. Originally it was named "Rudesheim Cognac." However, the Treaty of Versailles ending World War I decreed that the word Cognac could only be used for French products. Thus Hugo Asbach coined the term Weinbrand for German brandy. In 1924, Hugo Asbach created brandy-filled pralines ("brandy beans") at a time when it was considered to be in poor taste for women and alcohol to be seen together in public. Thus, the invention of "brandy beans" allowed ladies to enjoy brandy in public! **Celebrate Mass at a local church.** Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rudesheim. (B,D)

Day 4 May 17, Sunday: Heidelberg | Rothenburg ob der Tauber

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast at our hotel, we will check out and drive to Heidelberg, the romantic city of the "Student Prince" on the mouth of the Neckar River Valley. Upon arrival we'll tour the beautiful city of Heidelberg, seeing the castle, the town square, the Heiliggeist Church, and the old bridge. The highlight of our visit here will be the magnificent Gothic-Renaissance castle, which dominates the town from high above the river. Visit the castle yard and enjoy an unmatched view over the old town and the river. Visit the castle's most popular treasure: a mammoth wine cask with a capacity of 58,650 gallons. **End the morning with Mass at the Church of the Holy Spirit.**

During your independent lunch in Heidelberg, it is suggested that you try Spargel, German white asparagus. The center of the Spargel growing region is nearby and it is a spring ritual for Germans to enjoy the vegetable prepared in a variety of ways! This afternoon, we'll continue through the romantic Naker River Valley into the Oden Forest with its many castles and remnants of medieval fortresses to the Franconian town of Rothenburg ob der Tauber. A town straight from the Middle Ages, some call it Germany's "fairytale" city. Preserved with dedication and skill, it has withstood the ravages of time and war and gives us a glimpse into the past. The city boasts a complete city wall, charming wood-framed houses, a quaint town square, and St. Jacob's Church with a famous 500-year-old altarpiece by Tilman Riemenschneider, the Master of German woodcarvers. Lovely prints, carvings, wine glasses, Christmas ornaments, and beer steins are popular items to shop for in town. We will have free time before dinner at our hotel. This would be an ideal time to visit the Käthe Wohlfahrt Christmas store and Christmas museum!

After dinner, you may want to follow the Rothenburg Night Watchman on his entertaining and informative rounds through the town. You can walk through dark alleyways and across dimly lit squares and enjoy the special mood of the town at night. He'll tell stories about how the people lived in the Middle Ages, a special finale for our first day in historic and colorful Rothenburg!

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Rothenburg ob der Tauber. (B,D)

Day 5 May 18, Monday: Regensburg | Oberammergau

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast at our hotel, we will check out and drive to Regensburg, regarded as the medieval wonder of Germany. We'll enjoy a guided tour of the ancient castle and the city located on the banks of the Danube River. Here, Pope Benedict XVI was a professor at the University of Regensburg from 1969 to 1977. Visit St. Peter's Cathedral, the finest example of Gothic

architecture in southern Germany, and see the ancient city as we walk along her narrow walkways and stone bridges. **Celebrate Mass at St. Peter's Cathedral.** Independent lunch.

Continue to Oberammergau, home of the world-famous Passion Play. The play dates back to 1633 when the Plague, the "Black Death", took a severe toll of lives in the small village. In their distress, the inhabitants turned to God and vowed that if the plague was lifted, they would perform a play every ten years, depicting the suffering and death of the Savior. Their plea was heard and there were no further plague victims in Oberammergau. The first performance of the Passion play took place in 1634 in the village cemetery. Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Oberammergau or region. (B,D)

Day 6 May 19, Tuesday: Oberammergau the Passion Play

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. **After breakfast, celebrate private Mass at Maria Himmelfahrt in Garmisch.** Today we will attend the Passion Play in the renowned open-air theatre. The greatest story ever told comes to life as this superb production unfolds against a scenic backdrop of wooded mountains. The play begins with Christ's Entry into Jerusalem and continues with the story of Christ's Passion, Death, and Resurrection. The accompanying music is magnificent, and a full English translation of the script is available for you to follow from your reserved seat. All of the town members partake in this play every 10 years. There are two parts of the performance.

Part I: 2:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Part II: 8:00 p.m. to 10:30 p.m.

The dinner break lasts three hours (dinner is included in our arrangements).

Overnight at our hotel in Oberammergau or region. (B,D)

Day 7 May 20, Wednesday: Wieskirche | Neuschwanstein Castle | Salzburg

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we will check out and drive to visit Wieskirche, the impressive Rococo-era Pilgrimage Church of Wies designed in the 1740s. **Celebrate Mass at the Wieskirche.** After Mass, we'll explore King Ludwig's majestic Neuschwanstein Castle, the king's former residence built in 1869. Return to the times of Wagner as we visit the royal apartments decorated with scenes from German sagas and operas; the throne rooms and music halls, with fine candelabras and chandeliers; King Ludwig's unique bedroom with artistic wood carvings; and an artificial Grotto that recalls opera themes of his former friend and composer Richard Wagner. Independent lunch.

Continue to the Baroque city of Salzburg, a jewel set on the beautiful banks of the Salzach River, for a two-night stay. Check-in at our hotel.

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Salzburg. (B,D)

Day 8 May 21, Thursday: Berchtesgaden | Salt Mine | Eagles Nest

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. Today will provide us with a unique experience! After breakfast at our hotel, we will drive to Berchtesgaden for the Salt Mine tour. The mine brought prosperity to a very poor region when it opened in 1517. The salty rock is washed in water and the resulting brine is piped to a nearby town for refining. On our tour, we will don miner's overalls, take a small train ride, whoosh down wooden slides, and raft across an illuminated lake. Independent lunch.

Our next stop will be the Kehlsteinhaus, or Eagles Nest. Built as a tea house at 6020 feet in elevation on a mountain top, it was a gift to Hitler on his 50th birthday from the Nazi party. It is the only remaining Third-Reich era building. Views extend across the German and Austrian Alps with the glimmering Königssee below. **Celebrate Mass before dinner.**

Dinner and overnight at our hotel in Salzburg. (B,D)

Day 9 May 22, Friday: Salzburg | Munich | Farewell Dinner

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. This morning, we will be transferred to the Shrine of Maria Plain in Salzburg. In 1633, a painting of the Blessed Mother was found undamaged in the ruins of a burned-down wood house. In 1656 a small wooden chapel was built at this location and in 1710 the chapel was rebuilt to house the first copy of the miraculous image. In 1951 Pope Pius XII conferred the title of this Shrine to Basilica Minor. **Celebrate Mass at the Shrine.** After Mass, enjoy a highlights tour of Salzburg. Walk along Getreidegasse, the city's pedestrian street, lined with authentic 17th and 18th century buildings. We will stop to visit the house where Mozart was born. After our visit, continue to Salzburg's mountain, Mönchsberg, topped with the fortress Hohensalzburg. Built into the side of Mönchsberg is the Salzburg Festspielhaus, home of the famous Salzburg Festival Opera. See Residenzplatz, the center square of Salzburg, dominated by the largest baroque fountain north of the Alps. Next, visit St. Peter's Abbey, next to the cemetery where *The Sound of Music* was filmed.

After lunch, we'll leave Salzburg for Munich. Upon arrival we'll have an orientation tour of the second largest city in Germany. Our orientation tour will include a visit to the Marienplatz, the world-famous Glockenspiel, and the twin-towered Frauenkirche, the most familiar landmark of old Munich. You will see the town hall and the magnificent boulevard Feldherrenhalle Ludwigsstrasse Siegestor, created by King Ludwig I in the middle of the 19th century. Check-in at our hotel and freshen up. **This evening enjoy a festive dinner at the Hofbrauhaus in Munich.** Overnight at our hotel in Munich. (B,D)

Day 10 May 23, Saturday: Return to the USA

Buffet breakfast at our hotel. After breakfast, we will be transferred to Munich Airport for our return flight to New York's JFK International Airport. (B)

PAYMENT: Deposits and insurance payments will be accepted in the form of check, money order, or debit/credit card. All refund requests are subject to cancellation restrictions as set forth above. No refund will be made for any accommodations or services included in the tour that you do not use.

LATE RESERVATIONS: A \$25.00 fee and possible increase in airfare may apply for bookings received after the deposit deadline. All space is subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed past the deposit deadline noted on brochure.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: All participants must have a valid passport. U.S. Passports must be valid for at least six (6) months, subsequent to return date. Special entry requirements for non-U.S. citizens may apply. Please consult the appropriate Consulate for current requirements. It is solely the passenger's responsibility to ensure that all documents needed are completed and current. Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for lack of current and valid entry documents, including passport.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Round trip on Lufthansa from New York. Flight itinerary and carrier may be subject to change. Departure taxes & fuel surcharges are estimated. They are determined solely by the airlines and are subject to increase prior to ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Additionally, if you purchase any connecting airfare and the group does not materialize, or you cancel your package for any reason, Peter's Way Tours will not be held responsible for cost of this airfare.

AIRLINE SEATING: Under group airline reservations/contracts, the airlines will provide a block of seats for the group. Individual requests for seating preferences can only be made at time of check-in. Peter's Way cannot submit seating preferences as we cannot guarantee that any or all requests will be honored. If you require specific seating as a condition of your travel, it is suggested that you book your airfare individually and purchase the land only package. Upgrades to premium economy, business class, or first class may be available but oftentimes airlines will not allow the upgrades until time of ticketing (approximately 30 days prior to departure). Group reservations may not be accessible online for advance check-in/boarding passes/seat assignments. Airline guidelines vary. Please contact our office for specific details.

LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: Land Only packages do not include group airfare. All airline tickets will be your responsibility to book independently. A passenger choosing the land only portion of the package (Estimated: \$3,390.00 per person sharing a twin room - a \$100 cash discount will be applied if all payments are made by check) must notify Peter's Way Tours, in writing, 100 days prior to date of departure or a penalty fee will be assessed. Please be advised, passenger(s) opting for the Land Only package or who are deviating from the group itinerary will be responsible for their own transfers to/from hotel/airport. DEVIATIONS & ITINERARY CHANGES: Peter's Way Tours is pleased to assist clients with changes in itineraries. All deviation requests must be submitted in writing at least 90 days prior to departure. Deviation fee will apply plus an airline change fee. Your routing and dates requested will determine if a difference in airfare will also apply. TRANSFERS AND PORTERAGE: Round-trip airport transfers are included for passengers who purchase the full air and land package. Porterage of one piece of luggage throughout your tour at hotels is also included.

ACCOMMODATIONS/SINGLE TRAVELERS: Price per person is based on two people sharing a standard room with two twin beds and private facilities in hotels throughout your tour. Married couples may request a double/full bed, however, they are subject to availability. Triple occupancy may be requested. Triple rooms are standard rooms with two twin beds and a rollaway. Please note there is no discount for triple occupancy. Single rooms are limited but may be requested at time of booking. If confirmed an additional charge of \$695.00 will apply. Please note, single rooms are limited with Oberammergau package accommodations. Therefore, single travelers will be assigned a roommate for this 2-night stay only. We will make every effort (if you so desire) to match you with a same gender roommate when we receive your application, but we do not guarantee a roommate can be matched. If a single room must be assigned due to your roommate's cancellation, incompatibility or for any other reason (even at the last moment or while on tour), we must charge you the tour's single supplement or pro-rated amount.

MEALS: Buffet breakfast and dinner daily, including a farewell dinner at Hofbrauhaus in Munich.

GRATUITIES & SERVICE CHARGES: Gratuities are not included in your tour package. For good work, we recommend €4 Euro per person per day for your tour manager; €2 Euro per person per day for your bus driver; €1.50 Euro per person for a local guide when applicable. Other gratuities are usually handled individually. All service charges and local taxes as imposed by hotels are included in the program rate. Although service charges at the hotels are included, it is customary to leave €1 Euro per person for your waiter following dinner at the hotel and €1 Euro per person per day for housekeeping.
